



Ala Bendoraitienė – pianist, concertmaster, pedagogue. He studied piano at the Juozas Naujalis Art School in Kaunas (teachers Eva Ben Zvi and Birutė Storlienė). At the Lithuanian Academy of Music and Theater (LMTA) he studied with prof. Stasys Vainiūnas, prof. Mūza Rubackytė, trained as a chamber ensemble assistant with prof. Eugenijus Paulauskas. Interned with prof. Barbara Hesse-Bukowska (Poland).

As a soloist pianist, concertmaster, member of various chamber ensembles, Ala has participated in over 3,000 concerts in Lithuania, Latvia, France, Poland, Austria, Germany, Italy, Portugal, Spain, Denmark, Russia, Serbia, Holland, England, China, Costa Rica. A. Bendoraitienė played as a soloist with the Lithuanian State Symphony Orchestra (artistic director and chief conductor Gintaras Rinkevičius), with the Kaunas Chamber Orchestra, and the Lithuanian Chamber Orchestra. As a concertmaster, she has received diplomas from 18 prestigious international competitions.

He performed with famous Lithuanian and foreign artists: Zakhar Bron (Switzerland), Laszlo Hadady (France), Viktor Lyadov (Russia) and others.

A. Bendoraitienė is the first performer of many contemporary music works. She participated in the contemporary music festivals "Muzikinis Ruduo", "Gaida", "Century Music". She is a participant of poetry evenings organized by the M. Rastropovičius Foundation. in 2006 recorded his solo CD (Audio-CD) during the concert in Belgrade (Serbia).

in 1998 A. Bendoraitienei was awarded the title of expert concertmaster (at the National M.K. Čiurlionis School of Arts), assistant concertmaster (LMTA), and in 2018 - Expert qualification category of the piano teacher of the National M. K. Čiurlionis School of Arts. Her students are laureates of many national and international competitions.

As a member of the jury, she regularly participates in international competitions of pianists, concertmasters, chamber ensembles in Lithuania, Russia, Serbia, France, Costa Rica. She regularly conducts master's courses, lectures in Lithuania, Russia, France, China, Costa Rica, and writes articles. in 2008 she was granted the status of creator of Lithuanian art. Her radio recordings are heard in Lithuania, Latvia, Hungary, Serbia, France, BBC.

A. Bendoraitiene since 2014 initiated and organizes an international festival of contemporary music - a piano competition in Vilnius "Music of the Century". It is an ongoing project, held every two years alternately: in Lithuania (2018) and Costa Rica (2016). A. Bendoraitienė is awarded the diploma of "Cultural Ambassador Lithuania - Costa Rica".

in 2022 A. Bendoraitienė won the laureate title at the X International Master Competition for Music Teachers in Warsaw (Poland).
