



Nana Makharadze first stood on the stage of Tbilisi State Conservatoire at the age of 9 alongside the National Symphonic Orchestra - Conductor, widely honored Georgian artist and honored figure of Art - Jemal Gokieli. Her tutors were: Professors - V. Shiukashvili, E. Jakeli, V. Garnastaeva and Eduardo del Pueyo.

After graduating from Tbilisi State Conservatoire, she started working there at the Department of Chamber Music.

Around the same time, she became two-time diplomat of South Caucasus and Union competitions (Odessa, Khmel'nitsky, Baku, and Tbilisi). In 2008, she was also awarded the title of Laureate within the framework of the competition - "Music without limits". For some years she was continually conferred a title of the best tutor. In 2000, Honored Georgian tutor - Nana Makharadze - was awarded with Medal of Honor by president of Georgia E. Shevardnadze.

Her students have won more than 50 prizes at various competitions and festivals: Georgia, Lithuania, Armenia, Poland, Germany, Switzerland, France, Italy, Spain, Portugal, Denmark, The Netherlands, Finland, Norway, Austria and The USA.
