



Tatyana Shklovskaya – pianist, lecturer at Moscow Gnesin College, associate professor of the Maimonides State Classical Academy, winner of international competitions, cultural marker.

Tatyana Grigorievna Shklovskaya was born in March 6, 1953.

T. Shklovskaya currently splits her teaching between the Gnessin Special Music School (МССМШ им.Гнесиных), where she studied under prof.

I. Rodzevich and the State Classical Academy in Moscow. She is a graduate of the famous Gnessin Russian Academy of Music under prof. T. Gutman.

She was awarded a letter of thanks from the Ministry of Culture, an award certificate "For many years of pedagogical and educational activities".

T. Shklovskaya has produced talented musicians several times, and more than 1000 times her students have won various international competitions.

Tatyana actively promotes the traditions of the Russian piano school. Conducts masterclasses, open lessons, is a permanent member of the evaluation committee of national and international competitions.

Her students have won prizes in competitions and toured in various countries: France, Greece, Italy, Spain, Bulgaria, Great Britain, Scotland, Ukraine, Lithuania, Latvia, Austria, Hungary, Germany, Switzerland, USA, Korea and Vietnam.

He played with orchestras in the best European and Russian halls (Great, Small, S. Rachmaninov's halls at the Moscow Conservatory, St. Petersburg Philharmonic).
